**Timetables:** CSSC London Squash Club members can use squash courts at the South Bank Club every day:

**Monday to Friday:** from 6:30 am to 6:30 pm.

All games have to be finished by 6:30 pm. The last 40-minute court booking you can make is for a 5:40 pm start; the last 1-hour court booking you can make is for a 5:30 pm start.

**Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays:** all day (8:00 am to 8:00 pm).

<b>Membership fees:</b>	<p>Until June 2010, membership of the CSSC London Squash Club costs £50 for CSSC members. The membership fee for non-CSSC members will be £70.</p> <p>This entitles joiners to play squash at the South Bank Club during the times specified above.</p> <p>It also entitles joiners to use the following facilities:</p> <p><b>For free:</b> sauna, steam room and Jacuzzi pool in the ladies' changing rooms; sauna and steam room in the men's changing room. To be used when playing squash or using the South Bank Club fitness facilities.</p> <p><b>For £5 a session:</b> gym or any of the classes at South Bank Club, at any time during opening hours.</p> <p>Classes and gym sessions can be taken at any time during weekends and Bank Holidays but need to finish by 5:30 pm on weekdays.</p>
<b>Court fees:</b>	<p>Courts at the South Bank Club cost £5 per court for 40 minutes, and £6 per court for an hour.</p> <p>All courts have to be vacated by 6:30 pm Monday to Friday.</p>
<b>Court bookings:</b>	<p>It is advisable to book a court as soon as you have set up a game. Please call the South Bank Club to book courts.</p> <p>Please note that courts cannot be booked more than 7 days in advance.</p>
<b>Cancellation fees:</b>	<p>If you would like to cancel a court booking, please let South Bank Club know as soon as possible. South Bank Club will endeavour to sell the booking to another customer. If they do not succeed, you will incur a cancellation fee, which is the full cost of the court booking.</p>
<b>Racquet borrowing:</b>	<p>You can borrow a racquet for a game from the South Bank Club reception.</p>
